10. D. Wildman (Ottawa-Carleton Occasional Teacher Local) / D. Thur (Hastings-Prince Edward Occasional Teacher Local)

That ETFO lobby the Ministry of Education to have separate occasional teacher and teacher central bargaining tables.

11. K. Fry (Elementary Teachers of Toronto Local) / M. Major (Toronto Occasional Teacher Local)

That ETFO begin divesting all holdings in fossil fuels from our investment portfolio including but not limited to Transcanada Corp., the corporation behind the Keystone Pipeline.

12. M. Major (Toronto Occasional Teacher Local) / V. Lacasse (Elementary Teachers of Toronto Local)

That in all instances where the Canadian National Anthem is sung or played at ETFO events, an acknowledgement be stated that the current lyrics "in all thy sons command," and "God keep our land," are not inclusive or representative of women and non-religious people.

13. R. Millard (Elementary Teachers of Toronto Local) / S. Gartshore (Elementary Teachers of Toronto Local)

That until ETFO has made the necessary structural and procedural adjustments to satisfy members that the employee bargaining agency is authorized to enter into extension agreements, ETFO only engage in contract-related talks that include, as part of the process, the following:

- a) the opportunity for all members to give specific direction to the talks at the outset and to discuss and review the results of those talks in a contemporaneous, province-wide forum;
- b) the option for local unions to engage in bargaining with their respective boards;
- c) the choice for members to exercise their right to strike if they deem it necessary.
