1. C. Proulx-Wootton (Grand Erie Teacher Local)/M. Kargus (Grand Erie Teacher Local)
AMR 122

THAT ETFO provide a provincial conference that supports members who teach Music, Drama, Dance and Visual Arts.

2. C. Hoffman (Peel Teacher Local)/T. Malouba (Peel Teacher Local)
AMR 123

THAT ETFO reimburse locals for the cost of occasional teacher, DECE, ESP and PSP coverage when an Annual Meeting delegate or paid alternate requires coverage in the classroom.

3. C. McKibbin (Greater Essex County Teacher Local)/A. Pouti-Fletcher (Greater Essex County Teacher Local)
AMR 124

THAT ETFO provide a biennial French as a Second Language (FSL) Conference beginning in 2020-2021.

4. A. Korzack (Halton Designated Early Childhood Educator Local)/T. Matthews (Trillium Lakelands Designated Early Childhood Educator Local)
AMR 87

THAT Policy Statement, 25.0, Early Years, be amended by the addition of a new subsection to read:

“25.11 That all educational professionals shall be informed of and invited to meetings and trainings that concern the design, implementation or delivery of the Full-Day Kindergarten (FDK) program. This shall include, but not be limited to, the teacher, Designated Early Childhood Educator (DECE), Educational Support Personnel (ESP) and Professional Support Personnel (PSP).”
